

FOUNDER PAOLO MENUZZO, PIONEER OF AUTOMATION IN ITALY

The Chairman of CAME Group, Paolo Menuzzo founded the company in 1972. A pioneer of automation in Italy, with an entrepreneurial approach and an ability to devise far-sighted strategies, he managed to transform a small company in the outskirts of Treviso into one of the most renowned multinationals in the sector with 1500 employees and a turnover of 250 million euros. A business leader for 45 years, who is now at the helm of the CAME Group holding company, Paolo Menuzzo has developed a highly successful model, as evidenced by the constant growth of the company over many years, including double-digit growth.

He started working at a very young age, covering the length and breadth of the streets of the province of Treviso with his 2-horsepower Dyane, which is still on display in the company's headquarters.

In the 1970s, Paolo Menuzzo's creative flair, combined with his passion for technology and innovation, led to the patent of the first electromechanical motor for swing gates and subsequently to the introduction of a totally "invisible" underground engine to enhance the aesthetics of the gate.

Developing increasingly ambitious projects, Paolo Menuzzo enabled CAME to achieve leadership in a number of different sectors: access control, security systems, parking management, etc.

Menuzzo, despite the global scale of CAME's business, has maintained the company's roots in the local area. Paolo Menuzzo believes that people are the company's most valuable resources and must therefore be valued, ensuring their well-being.
